As the youth coaching arm of one of the most successful football clubs in the world, LFC IA strives to be a world leader in developing children through football.



PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

LONG TERM PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

Long term player development and players enjoying their football are at the core of our playing and coaching philosophy. We develop all players at LFC in the five key areas, with age and ability-appropriate programs.

We always prioritise what is best for the player, keeping them at the centre of our development model. We feel an attacking style of play based on effective possession of the ball is the best style to improve learning and development.

Through our coaching curriculum and coach accreditation process, LFC coaches around the world are learned in developing players in line with this model.



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PHASES OF DEVELOPMENT

The LFC program is split into four age-specific phases. These are:

- 1. Pre-Academy (up to U8)
- 2. Foundation Phase (U9-U11)
- 3. Youth Development Phase (U12-U16)
- 4. Professional Development Phase (U17+)

Within each phase, we consider the Development Model at all times, focussing on those five key areas (tactical, physical, mental, social, technical) and always keeping the player at the centre of it.

WINNING VS DEVELOPMENT

Everyone loves to win, no more so than at Liverpool FC. However, for young players around the world, we know that enjoying your football is the most important aspect and it's not always about winning. Observing development and progress is how we measure success in young players at LFC.

We want to develop children through football, helping them to become the best possible version of themselves, both on and off the pitch. We identify achievable goals and help them to hit those targets and do so with a smile on their face.

BEING A POSITIVE PARENT



PARENT DOS

- Have fun, smile and enjoy yourself!
- Stay in designated spectator areas. Do not enter the field of play
- Encourage players on both teams
- Celebrate effort and good play from both teams and all players
- Respect the match officials
- Respect the coaches and club staff
- Treat facilities with respect

PARENT DON'TS

- Use foul and abusive language
- Tolerate other parents using foul and abusive language
- React negatively to mistakes
- Shout tactical instructions
- Disagree with the coach
- Interact negatively with opponents, players or spectators


LFC eACADEMY
